## JJ Ringworm Treatment

This product is to be used as supplied and not diluted. If Ringworm is seen or diagnosed follow these procedures.

### Directions for use:

1. If you are able, wash the patient off using JJ Shampoo and rinse down. While the coat is still damp apply JJ Ringworm Treatment.
2. Liberally apply JJ Ringworm Treatment to and around the infected area gently spreading with a sponge.
3. Allow the coat to air dry. Re-apply JJ Ringworm Treatment daily for five days for best results.

If you feel your patient requires a rug, then the rug should also be treated using JJ Infection Control Disinfectant diluted 1 to 5 with water. This is because if the rug has been on the patient then it will continually re-infect your patient.

**Ingredients:** Homeo-Harmonised Water (Aqua), "Sterichelle" (Alkyl Dimethyl Benzyl Ammonium Chloride, Alkyl Ethyl Benzyl Ammonium Chloride).

**Appearance:** clear, colourless liquid.
